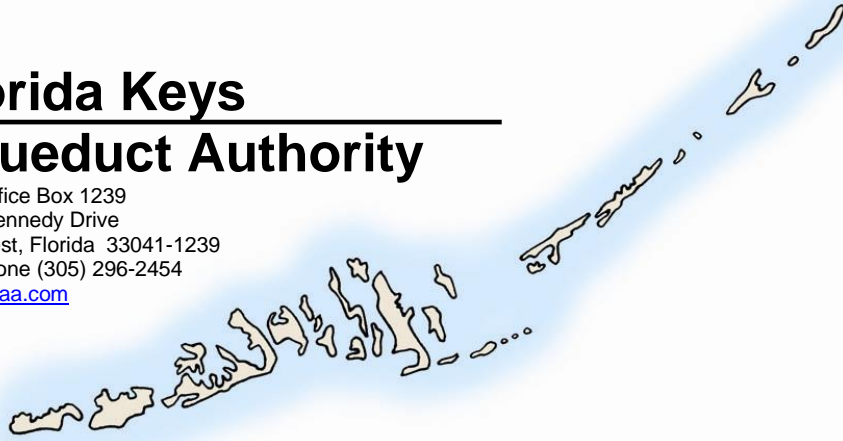

The Florida Keys Aqueduct Authority (FKAA) is committed to providing Monroe County/Florida Keys residents and visitors with a safe and reliable supply of high quality drinking water. The FKAA water meets state and federal standards for both appearance and safety. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency requires utilities to mail by July 1st of each year an annual water quality report (often referred to as the “Consumer Confidence Report”) to customers as part of the Safe Drinking Water Act. This report is based on the results of monitoring for the period of January 1 to December 31, 2008. It explains where your water comes from, how your water is treated, what our tests show about your water, and other things you should know about your water.
